Prerequisites for this Course

Students must have a laptop or other portable computer to bring to class each week. Adobe Photoshop Elements (the current version) must be installed on the computer for student to use during class each week and for working in on their own outside of class time. No book is required for this course, but the instructor may recommend some options to the students.

Course Description

This course is a beginning level software training course. No previous experience is necessary. We will discuss general topics about digital imaging (i.e. resolution and image size, color correction) while covering the tools and controls in the program. Assignments will be worked through during class each week. This course is designed to develop your image-editing skills and provide you with an understanding of what is capable in digital imaging.
